The MVEESC High School Mentorship Program is an excellent learning opportunity available to juniors and seniors to explore a potential profession they are interested in pursuing someday. Students develop a learning relationship with an adult in the field of study they hope to pursue with on-site learning, online assignments and reflections, and virtual learning opportunities. The MVEESC Director of Gifted Education works directly with your School Counselors. Successful completion of the MVEESC High School Mentorship Program will result in a high school graduate credit along with earning the Local Student Engagement Graduation Seal, per district school board approval. In addition, the MVEESC Director of Gifted Education has worked with ACC Behavioral Health to offer paid internships to our juniors and seniors pursuing a field of study in behavioral health as well as to our high school graduates. More internship opportunities are in development.

Note:

It is recommended that students have a higher GPA (3.0+) as they will need to manage this mentorship experience on top of their current course schedule for this academic year. This MVEESC High School Mentorship also provides gifted service to identified students.
