**Reimbursement rates:**

We receive 98% of our meals at the free rate and 2% at the paid rate.

**8550 - COMPETITIVE FOOD SALES**

To comply with Ohio Revised Code 3313.814 our district has adopted and continues to enforce Board Policy 8550. Contact: [jennifer.andrews@coshoctoncityschools.com](mailto:jennifer.andrews@coshoctoncityschools.com) for approval of food and beverages to be sold during the school day.

**Key points of policy:**

*Food Service Department shall be the sole provider of food and beverages sold until 30 minutes after the last lunch period. OTHER ORGANIZATIONS CANNOT SELL FOOD OR DRINKS DURING LUNCH.*

*Any food or beverage items sold and consumed by students during the school day, must meet USDA dietary guidelines for Americans and USDA Smart Snack nutrition standards. This includes sales from vending machines, fundraisers, student clubs, and parent groups.*
