## **INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES**

Quote form must be completed before license can be processed. The start date of license is for customer (Licensee) to select. Swank Movie Licensing USA (Licensor) does not provide copy of the physical movie content; however, Licensee may use any legally obtained copy (including copy owned, borrowed or rented from a legal source) in order to show films corresponding with the license provided herein. This license authorizes unlimited movie showings by anyone on school property, regardless of whether or not they are affiliated with the school. Outdoor screenings on school property are allowed for by this license but are limited to students, faculty, staff and their families/friends ("School Community"). Outdoor movie events intended for audiences outside of School Community or open to the general public are not covered by this license.

## **LICENSE TERM AND LICENSE COPYRIGHT RESTRICTIONS**

The start date of this license selected by Licensee shall commence upon execution of this Public Performance Licensing agreement and will continue for 12 months unless otherwise indicated in writing. This license is for K-12 schools only. The movie content being utilized, regardless of how legally obtained, may not be altered, duplicated, digitized or transmitted electronically in any form without specific permission from the copyright owner. Licensor has the right to add or delete any studio throughout the course of the license period. A current list of available studios can be found on our website; or upon request. Violation of this agreement is subject to the penalties set forth in the Federal Copyright Act. This Site License is scheduled to renew at the end of Licensee's selected initial agreement; may, however, request cancellation any time after the initial term of the agreement. Approximately one month prior to expiration, the renewal packet will be mailed. The Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Licensor from any claims, damages, or expenses arising from the Licensee's failure to obtain the necessary licenses.

## **LICENSE INVOICE AND PAYMENT TERMS**

Sales tax liability, if applicable, in this Quote may be an estimate. The actual amount may vary on the invoice due to changes in tax laws, rates or taxability. Licensor will render detailed invoice to Licensee immediately upon execution of this agreement; or in alignment with license start date if otherwise noted. All invoices are due and payable upon receipt of invoice. Licensee is responsible for payment of all outstanding amounts including applicable sales, use or similar taxes, if it is determined that the Licensee is not tax exempt eligible. Refunds are not granted after the license has been processed; however, Licensee may request cancellation any time after the initial term of agreement.
