### **Team Records**

- **Football**
  - **2-8 - Hired Brock Bolden**
- **Volleyball**
  - **5 - 18 - Hired Steve Brown**
  - **Bringing back every starter and Lilah Laaper after missing her whole Junior Year and signing Division 1 at Austin Peay**
- **Golf - no record given but Bransyn Dawson was 2 strokes from moving on.**
- **Girls Soccer**
  - **8-8-2**
  - **Brings back 90% of starters and Zoey Tumblin who was All-Ohio and one of the best players in the East District**
- **Boys Soccer**
  - **4-12-2**
  - **Conner turning program around**
  - **Close to 30 young men played soccer last year. Had a JV and Varsity Team**
  - **The record wasn't showing the growth that was made but with half the roster as 9th graders who were starting progress is being made.**
- **Boys Basketball**
  - **13-12**
  - **Beat a tough Martins Ferry team who they have been competing against the last several years**
  - **Took a very talented St. C team to the wire.**
  - **Bring back 95% of roster with 2 9th graders and 3 10th graders who earned a lot of playing time.**

  - **True bounce back year for this squad. Had to play a unique schedule and finished with 11 wins. We did play a few teams that were "considered" varsity teams but the best part was the girls tasted victory and are bringing everyone back.**

- **Wrestling**
  - #’s skyrocketed.
  - Held Districts for the 2nd time in a row and have benefited the program by using the money they raised to get students better equipment.
  - Was able to host a few JH events and more wrestling than we have had at home in quite some time.
  - Had a few young men make it to districts and have years of experience still left.
  - FIRST ever girl made it to districts in Ava Wells. She did great and as a 9th grader still has some time to get where she needs to be.
